







Or consider our Semat refuse body. Designed to fit onto any chassis, it is available in multiple sizes and, again, offers a very short rear overhang. Titan refuse collection vehicles

Delivering fuel savings of as much as 15%, Titan is clearly a more environmentally friendly way of keeping Britain tidy.

Attention to detail has always been the hallmark of CPD. Take the Titan RCV for example.

Robust, aesthetically pleasing – and with a low-maintenance compaction unit – the Titan XLS body is capable of handling all waste streams.

With five pre-set compaction ratios built into its operating software, Titan is sufficiently versatile to collect domestic waste, green waste, trade waste, paper waste and recycled materials.

Thanks to 'next generation' hydraulics, Titan's 14-second compaction cycle (the industry standard is 18 – 22 seconds) reduces collection time. Requiring only 890rpm to drive the compaction process, Titan's compaction cycle is also particularly quiet at 65dB(A).

Delivering resultant fuel savings of as much as 15%, Titan is clearly a more environmentally friendly way of keeping Britain tidy.

And because functionality is just as important as efficiency, Titan's cab control screen provides a host of vital information for operators – including bin counter, unloading procedure and rear view camera.

Add a choice of capacities from 16m³ to 27m³ and there's a Titan variant to suit your requirements.







Titan 2406 bin lifter

The Titan 2406 low-level bin lifter raises efficiency and capability to a whole new level.

Titan bin lifters offer minimal overhang, enhanced loading efficiency and high safety standards, while a powered rave plate ensures that sacks and bulky items can be handled safely and efficiently.

A seven-second lift cycle accelerates collections. The loading of bulky items is made easier thanks to a full body width design and a higher payload weight is achieved due to an extremely tough yet low weight lifter.

Better manoeuvrability is achieved thanks to the Titan lifter's exceptionally short overhang.

Putting safety first, the system's patented inflatable barrier arms have been developed to significantly reduce damage costs and enhance both operator and public safety.









Semat refuse collection vehicles

With gross vehicle weights from 10 tonnes to 32 tonnes, the Semat range of pivot-link rear-loaders will easily meet all your collection requirements.

At CPD, we have been building RCVs with Semat Cargopac bodies since 1996. Indeed, for many of our municipal customers, the flexibility that Semat offers makes it the only choice.

Ecopac food waste vehicles

The Titan Ecopac is ideal for satellite collections, and its compact wheelbase provides easy operation.

Built to the same exacting standards as our Titan and Semat RCVs, the Ecopac is ideally suited to food waste collections along narrow lanes, as well as in busy towns and city centres.

Available in capacities from 6m³ to 8m³ and with payloads up to 3,500kg, Titan Ecopac vehicles feature a rearloading mini-compactor and a 'tipping' discharge system.

Rear bin lift options range from 80 litres to 750 litres, and the Ecopac's compact wheelbase and narrow body ensure easy operation.

Manual and automatic compaction cycles and an articulated single-blade compacting system provide highly efficient loading, while the compaction system's reverse capability assists with waste discharge.

Standard features include PLC control of Ecopac functions, CCTV system with 7-inch colour screen and rear camera, PTO digital counter and 'man present' button for lift container use.







Telstar road maintenance vehicles


